

Sally & Possum is an innovative television series for young children who are deaf or hard of hearing and whose primary language is Auslan (Australian sign language).

The series, developed by specialist teachers of the deaf, combines live action with animation to create a visually rich and rewarding experience. It promotes the relevance and understanding among Australian people who are deaf or hard of hearing.

Aligned with the Early Years Learning Framework and using play based learning, the episodes are both educational and exciting.

Explore stories

Follow the adventures of Sally & Possum as they explore, discover and learn using Auslan.

Best friends Sally & Possum do everything together! Whether it's making delicious smooth icing for a cake or flying high in a hot air balloon, they turn ordinary life into an imaginative and exciting journey.

In each episode Sally & Possum, with a little help from their friends, use sign language to interact as they find fun-filled solutions to everyday problems, learning and laughing as they go.

The six series, comprising 90 episodes, are delivered wholly in Auslan with English voiceovers.

Access the learning resources

Sally & Possum was developed primarily to support the literacy and numeracy development of young children who are deaf or hard of hearing.

A teacher and educator resource package aligning with the Australian Curriculum and Queensland kindergarten learning guideline has been developed. The package complements series 1–6 of Sally & Possum videos and is available on the Queensland Early Childhood Education and Care website.

The resource package guides teaching and learning opportunities in early childhood and early years of school settings through the use of Sally and Possum episodes.

The resources are not tools to teach Auslan under the Australian Curriculum, rather the resources complement the Australian Curriculum.
