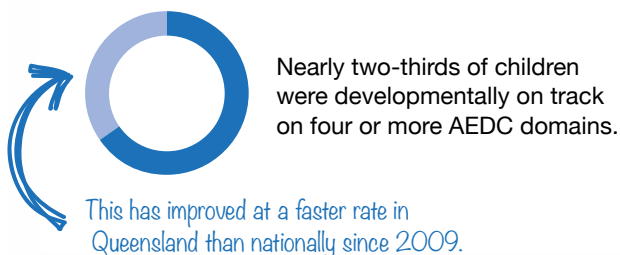
## Trends from the AEDC 2009 to 2018

The AEDC is a measure of young children's development at the start of their first year of full-time school.

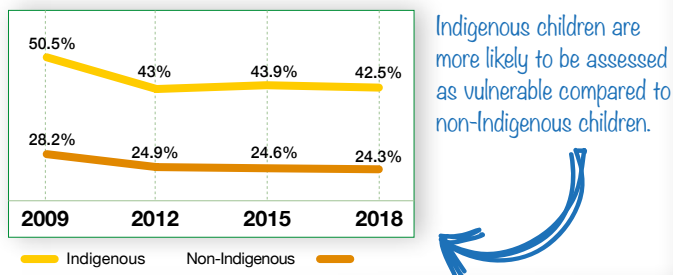

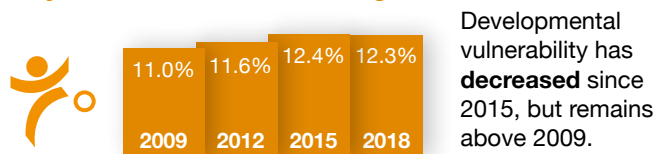


The proportion of Indigenous children who were developmentally vulnerable on one or more domain(s) has **decreased** since 2009.

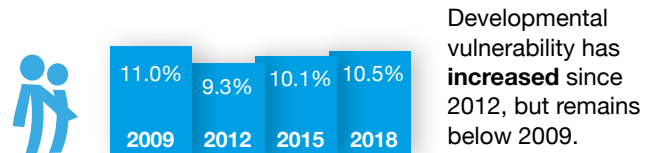

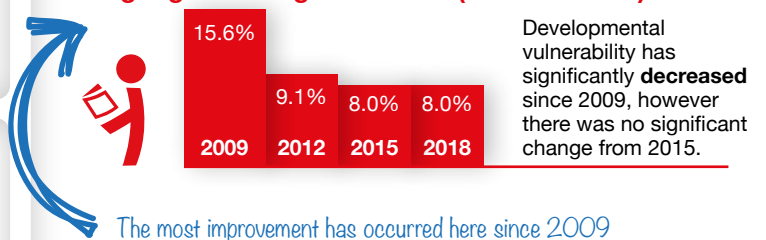

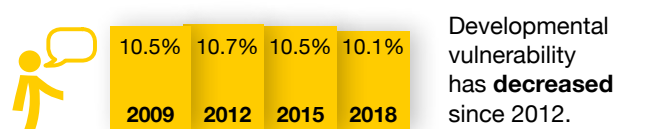
