What is a playgroup?

A playgroup is an informal session where babies and young children and families or caregivers regularly meet in a relaxed environment. They are usually held once a week in community venues such as a local school, hall or park.

Playgroup Queensland playgroups are run by participating families or volunteers.

Why playgroups are good for children

Playgroups are fun. Your child will join in different play activities suitable for their age including singing, dancing, art and craft.

At playgroup, your child will:

- ▶ try out new imaginative and creative activities
