The program provides age-appropriate learning opportunities based on the Queensland kindergarten learning guideline (QLG) and is tailored to meet the unique needs of rural, remote and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and families.

Early years and early childhood teachers deliver the kindergarten program in composite or non-composite settings. Both settings are designed to meet the local school and kindergarten context.

Seek adventure, career growth and permanent employment opportunities.


