1. Details of person to whom the enforcement action relates	Educator (Lead) – Centre based service
2. Nature of Enforcement Action	Enforceable undertaking
3. Reason for Enforcement Action	An educator has breached section 166(3) of the Education and Care Services National Law – Offence to use inappropriate discipline
4. Date of agreed undertaking	<b>8 May 2020</b>
5. Details of Enforceable Undertaking	<p>The educator will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Notify her employer within 7 days of the enforceable undertaking.</li> <li>2. Notify future employers within the education and care sector of the enforceable undertaking, while it is in effect.</li> <li>3. Refrain from holding the position of lead educator or responsible person of an education and care service for 12 months following the enforceable undertaking.</li> <li>4. At the educator's expense, enrol in and complete the five training modules, as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Managing challenging exchanges module – Early Childhood Australia</li> <li>b. Advanced safe sleeping for early childhood educators – Red Nose</li> <li>c. Stress management – Paramount Training</li> <li>d. Anger management</li> <li>e. Managing workplace anxiety – Paramount Training</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. Provide evidence to the Regulatory Authority of enrolment in each course within three months of the enforceable undertaking.</li> <li>6. Provide evidence to the Regulatory Authority of completion of each course within six months of the enforceable undertaking.</li> </ol>
6. Steps taken	The educator has agreed to the details of the Enforceable Undertaking.
