2. Nature of Enforcement Action	Suspension of Service Approval

Reason for Enforcement Action	<p>The service approval was suspended following a show cause process on the grounds that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. the Regulatory Authority reasonably believes that the continued operation of the education and care service would constitute an unacceptable risk to the safety, health or wellbeing of any child or class of children being educated and cared for by the education; and</li> <li>b. a condition of the service approval has not been complied with, namely:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. that the education and care service is operated in a way that ensures the safety, health and wellbeing of the children being educated and cared for by the service.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>	
0. Details of the Enforcement Actions	<p>The suspension is effective from midnight on 20 October 2017            The suspension is revoked from midnight on 19 January 2018</p>	
1. Notes	<p>The decision to suspend the service approval for a period of 3 months was made by the Regulatory Authority on 20 March 2017 under s 79 of the <i>Education and Care Services National Law (Queensland)</i> with effect from 3 April 2017. An application for review of the original decision was lodged with the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT) on 29 March 2017. QCAT imposed a stay on the original decision on 7 April 2017 pending determination of the review. On 6 October 2017, QCAT confirmed the original decision and ordered that the suspension of service approval for a period of 3 months take effect from midnight on the 14<sup>th</sup> day after the date on which the decision was delivered (20 October 2017).
