Reason for Enforcement Action	<p>The Regulatory Authority issued a show cause notice before prohibition on the reasonable belief that the educator may pose an unacceptable risk of harm to a child or children if the educator was to continue to provide education and care to children.</p> <p>The enforceable undertaking was a negotiated alternative form of enforcement action.</p>
4. Date of agreed undertaking	6 August 2019
5. Details of Enforceable Undertaking	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The educator undertakes to enrol in courses specified by the Regulatory Authority within 6 months of 6 August 2019, and complete said courses within 12 months of 6 August 2019. As follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Epilepsy essentials – delivered by Epilepsy Action Australia; b. Duty of care for workers – delivered by Early Childhood Australia; c. HLTAID001 – Provide cardiopulmonary Resuscitation; and d. CHC50113 – Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. 2. The educator will provide evidence of completion of the above courses no later than 5 August 2020; and 3. The educator will not be employed in a supervisory capacity (i.e. Lead Educator or Nominated Supervisor) for 12 months from 6 August 2020 and subject to the successful completion of the specified courses.
6. Steps taken	The educator has agreed to the details of the Enforceable Undertaking.
