1. Details of person to whom the enforcement action relates	Educator – Centre based service
2. Nature of Enforcement Action	Enforceable undertaking
3. Reason for Enforcement Action	The Regulatory Authority issued a show cause notice before prohibition on the reasonable belief that the educator may pose an unacceptable risk of harm to a child or children if the educator was to continue to provide education and care to children. The enforceable undertaking was a negotiated alternative form of enforcement action
4. Date of agreed undertaking	<b>9 August 2019</b>
5. Details of Enforceable Undertaking	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The educator will, at the educator's own expense, enrol in and complete the following training courses: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Epilepsy Management 3 – delivered by Epilepsy Action Australia</li> <li>b. Provide First Aid Plus – delivered by St Johns First Aid</li> <li>c. Lead to inspire – delivered by ECTARC</li> <li>d. Communication and team building – delivered by ECTARC</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Enrolment in the courses to occur no later than 08.02.2020.</li> <li>3. Completion of the courses to occur by 08.08.2020.</li> <li>4. The educator will not be employed in a supervisory capacity (i.e. Lead Educator or Nominated Supervisor) at an education and care service until 09.08.2020 and before successful completion of the agreed training courses.</li> </ol>
