2. Nature of Enforcement Action	Enforceable undertaking
3. Reason for Enforcement Action	The Regulatory Authority issued a show cause notice before prohibition on the reasonable belief that the educator may pose an unacceptable risk of harm to a child or children if the educator was to continue to provide education and care to children. The enforceable undertaking was a negotiated alternative form of enforcement action.
4. Date of agreed undertaking	15 August 2019
5. Details of Enforceable Undertaking	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The educator will undertake to enrol in the following training courses: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Epilepsy Essentials – delivered by Epilepsy Action Australia. b. Rethinking supervision – delivered by ChildAustralia.org c. Self- regulation; identify, reflect and respond – delivered by ChildAustralia.org. 2. The educator will complete the training courses no later than 14 August 2020 3. The educator will provide evidence to the Regulatory Authority of completion of the courses. 4. The educator will not be employed in a supervisory capacity (i.e. Responsible person or Nominated Supervisor) until 15 August 2020 and successful completion of the agreed training courses has occurred.
6. Steps taken	The educator has agreed to the details of the Enforceable Undertaking.
