2. Nature of Enforcement Action	Enforceable undertaking
3. Reason for Enforcement Action	The Regulatory Authority issued a show cause notice before prohibition on the reasonable belief that the educator may pose an unacceptable risk of harm to a child or children if the educator was to continue to provide education and care to children. The enforceable undertaking was a negotiated alternative form of enforcement action.

The educator will at the educator's expense, enrol in and complete the training modules from the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care , St John's Ambulance and In Safe Hands: as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. CHCECE002 – ensure the health and safety of children b. CHCECE016 – Establish and maintain a safe and healthy environment c. CHCECE019 – Facilitate compliance in an education and care service d. First Aid Training – Emergency first aid in childcare e. Work Health and Safety Course 2. Provide evidence of completion of the above modules to the Regulatory Authority by 21 November 2020.
