2. Nature of Enforcement Action	Enforceable undertaking
3. Reason for Enforcement Action	The Regulatory Authority issued a show cause notice before prohibition under Section 182(3)(a) of the Education and Care Services National Law on the reasonable belief that the educator was not a fit and proper person to be nominated as a nominated supervisor of a service.. The enforceable undertaking was a negotiated alternative form of enforcement action.
4. Date of agreed undertaking	16 December 2019
5. Details of Enforceable Undertaking	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The educator will at the educator's expense, enrol in and complete the training modules as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. St Johns Ambulance – provide emergency first aid response in childcare; b. In Safe Hands – emergency procedures and response in early education and care; c. In Safe Hands – Work Health and Safety; and d. CHCECE002 - Ensure the health and safety of children 2. Provide evidence of completion of modules a-c within six weeks of the enforceable undertaking. 3. Enrol in training module d. within two months of the enforceable undertaking and provide evidence of completion to the Regulatory Authority
6. Steps taken	The educator has agreed to the details of the Enforceable Undertaking. The enforceable undertaking was fully discharged on 4 March 2020.
