2. Reason for Enforcement Action	<p>An educator has breached section 166(4) of the National Law - Offence to use inappropriate discipline</p> <p>An educator has breached regulation 99(3) of the National Regulations – Children leaving the education and care service premises</p>
3. Date of Agreed Undertaking	13 February 2017
4. Details of the Enforceable Undertaking	<p>The educator will, at the educator's own cost enrol in and complete the following three modules delivered by Family Day Care Association QLD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supporting children's behaviour.</li> <li>• Care for children – routines and practices.</li> <li>• Work legally and ethically.</li> </ul> <p>The educator will complete the modules and provide evidence of completion to the Regulatory Authority by <b>1 August 2017</b>.</p> <p>The educator will ensure that all children being educated and cared for by the educator are not subjected to inappropriate discipline.</p> <p>The educator will ensure that children will only leave the service if they are released into the care of a parent, authorised nominee or person authorised by the parent or authorised nominee named in the child's enrolment record to collect the child from the premises.</p>
