1. Nature of Enforcement Action	Enforceable Undertaking
2. Reason for Enforcement Action	An educator has breached section 165(3) of the National Law - Offence to inadequately supervise children by failing to ensure that all children being educated and cared for as part of a family day care service were adequately supervised.
3. Date of Agreed Undertaking	30 January 2017
4. Details of the Enforceable Undertaking	<p>The educator will enrol in the following two units of competency with a reputable Registered Training Organisation that offers the units through either face to face or online delivery:</p> <p>(a) CHCECE002 – Ensure the health and safety of children (b) CHCECE015 – Attend to daily functions in home based child care</p> <p>The educator will complete the units of competency and provide evidence of completion to the Regulatory Authority by 1 August 2017.</p> <p>The educator will ensure that all children in their care are adequately supervised by the educator, or another educator properly approved under the National Law, at all times that the children are in the educator's care.</p>
5. Steps taken	The educator has agreed to the Details of the Enforceable Undertaking.
