





# Free Kindy for Queensland families

Every child deserves a strong start to their education – that's why kindy is free for Queensland families.

Kindergarten, known as kindy, is a part-time educational program for children in the year before Prep. Kindy is 15 hours per week, 40 weeks per year and is free for Queensland children attending a government-approved kindergarten program.

Kindergarten programs are offered in long day care services and sessional kindergarten services. Sessional kindergartens operate during school hours each school term, whereas long day care services can provide a kindergarten program as part of their extended hours of care.

Families should speak to their local kindergarten program provider regarding the start date of their child's kindergarten program.

Free kindy means every eligible child will have access to high-quality early education, setting them up for a strong and successful future. Providing free, inclusive, and accessible quality kindergarten sets children up for a strong start in life.

Queensland families can access free quality kindergarten programs for their child in both sessional and long day care services. Kindergarten enrolments are now open for 2025.

Queensland families are encouraged to use the online *free kindy finder* to locate their nearest free government-approved kindergarten program provider.





## Educational program for 4-year-olds

Children aged at least 4 years of age by 30 June in the year before they attend Prep.



### 15 hours per week, 40 weeks per year

Kindy is 15 hours per week, 40 weeks per year and is FREE.



## With a qualified early childhood teacher

A kindergarten program is delivered by a qualified early childhood teacher.



## At approved free kindy program providers

A government-approved educational program offering free kindy in sessional or long day care.

## 15 hours of kindy

Kindy is a government-approved educational program for 15 hours per week, 40 weeks per year and is free. Kindy is delivered in different ways at different services. For some services, 15 hours of free kindy might be delivered over two or three days, with additional care paid for separately. If a child attends kindy in a long day care setting, additional care may be covered in part by the Australian Government Child Care Subsidy.





# Free Queensland Government-approved kindergarten program identifier - 'kindy tick'

All free kindergarten approved program providers will display the kindy tick. Families are encouraged to look for the kindy tick to access the Queensland Government-approved kindy.





## **Key Messages**

- Kindy is free for Queensland families.
- Kindy is for children aged at least 4 years of age by 30 June in the year before they start Prep.
- Kindy is 15 hours per week, 40 weeks per year and is FREE.
- Kindy is free at both sessional kindergartens or long day care services.
- Free kindy helps reduce the cost of living for all Queensland families.
- Kindy is a part-time educational program for children in the year before they start Prep.
- Kindy is inclusive and for all Queensland families.
- Participation in kindy offers lifelong benefits, and leads to positive long-term outcomes for children.

- Keep an eye out for the kindy tick to show that a kindy is a Queensland Governmentapproved kindergarten program and is offering free kindy.

- Talk to your local free kindy program provider about enrolling in kindy.
- Eligible families attending long day care services may also be able to access cheaper childcare through the Australian Government's Child Care Subsidy.


