

How To Make A Kite



Step1:

Place the dowels in a cross with the horizontal dowel a quarter down the length of the vertical down on a piece of cloth tape.



Step2:

Secure the tape around the horizontal dowel. Place a piece of cloth tape on the intersection and secure it around the vertical dowel.

Step3:

Lay the dowel-structure on the kite material and secure the material with at each corner with cloth tape to the dowels.



Step4:

Turn the kite around and using a sharp instrument make a small hole on each side of the horizontal dowel halfway from ends. Thread a piece of string through the hole and tie to the dowel. You can use cloth tape to secure the string. When the string is pulled taught, it should not extend past the top part of the kite. Centre the string and tie a loop.



Step5:

Using thin strips of the kite fabric or similar, make a tail 7 times the length of the kite and tie the tail to the bottom part of the kite.



Step6:

Tie the string to the kite and enjoy!
