Supporting our workforce

A high-quality and capable early childhood education and care workforce will ensure that our children get a strong start and thrive to reach their full potential.

The <u>Queensland Early Childhood Workforce Strategy</u> has been developed in consultation with the sector, including representatives from family day care, outside school hours care, long day care, kindergarten and early years services.

At the centre of the strategy is a strong focus on supporting our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and culturally diverse early childhood professionals, and fostering codesign of local solutions to meet changing community and workforce needs.

The strategy identifies six priority areas:

- ✓ Professional recognition
- ✓ Strong leadership identity
- ✓ Qualification, skills and pathways
- ✓ Attraction and maintain expertise
- ✓ Health, wellbeing and resilience
- ✓ Enhance workforce expertise.

The key areas to ensure all Queensland children have a strong start and receive a quality early education are:

- Rural and Remote incentives
- Practicum Placement Scheme
- Early Childhood Practicum Placement Grant
- Early Childhood Planning Subsidy for long day care

- Workforce Planning Support

Unlock your career in early childhood with Fee-Free TAFE

There are a number of fee-free TAFE courses in Early Childhood Education and Care for school leavers. Free training means the full cost of the course fees are covered.

The offer covers a Certificate III on its own or as part of a traineeship, and a Diploma as part of an apprenticeship.

Where can I work?

Holders of a Certificate III, can work as an assistant educator in long day care, kindergarten or as an assistant in a kindergarten, or coordinator in a family day care or outside school hours care service.

The Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care provides employment as a lead educator in long day care, or as an assistant educator in a kindergarten, or coordinator in a family day care or outside school hours care service. Long version - The Early Childhood Practicum Placement Grant

New grant supports future early childhood teachers

Are you a student looking to unlock your career in early childhood?

The Early Childhood Practicum Placement Grant offers financial support of up to \$5,000 for those studying an early childhood undergraduate degree or postgraduate qualification who complete their final work placement in a service delivering an approved kindergarten program.

The Early Childhood Practicum Placement Grant is for eligible students not currently working in the sector who will complete their minimum consecutive 15-day practicum placement in an approved kindergarten program (long day care or sessional kindergarten).

Eligible early childhood undergraduate and postgraduate students can apply for the grant once they have completed their final practicum placement—either in semester 2, 2024, 2025, 2026 or 2027.
